Firm Wins Defibrillator Contract

Guilford-based Defibtech announced Wednesday it had a \$17 million contract to supply almost 1,700 defibrillators to the state of New Jersey.

The three-year contract will let the state outfit police cars with the lifesaving medical technology, enabling officers to revive people suffering from sudden cardiac arrest.

Defibrillators supply an electric charge that can shock the heart back into beating.

Defibtech co-founder and President Gintaras Vaisnys said the company manufactures the defibrillators in Connecticut.
