



Cintas Corporation Announces 50th Life Saved by AED

CINCINNATI, OH, February 19, 2008 —
On Dec. 7, 2007, a suburban Kansas City, MO truck driver became the 50th person whose life was saved by a Cintas “ReviveR” automatic electronic defibrillator (AED).

Today, Stephen Hanes, 45, was reunited with Sugar Creek Fire Department Acting Deputy Fire Chief Ben Schaumberg, credited with saving Hanes’ life after responding to a 911 call at his residence. The reunion took place at the Sugar Creek City Hall in Sugar Creek, MO.

“I was just sitting there watching TV and my wife was walking [through the room], and that’s the last thing I remember,” Hanes said. “The next thing I remember I was in the ambulance, and they had told me that I had sudden cardiac death.”

Firefighter Schaumberg said he has administered the AED on patients about a dozen times, but this was the first time he saved a life with the equipment since the department purchased two AED devices from Cintas in May 2005.

“For our department, getting AEDs has been a huge step forward. Before, all we could do was take a pulse and start CPR,” Schaumberg said. “At least with this machine, it can tell us what’s going on. It actually helps us think a little bit clearer because the AEDs remind us what to do.”

Hanes is thankful for the quick response of the Fire Department and its use of the Reviver. “Your device is wonderful. The firefighters are just too good,” Hanes said. “They give your company all the credit in the world. They told me I was gone that quick.”
