

### Defibtech Offers Training, Defibrillator to GFL

Guilford Free Library staff got a morning jolt of learning on Dec. 16 when Defibtech North East Account Manager Louis Iannotti offered a demonstration on how to properly use the Lifeline View automated external defibrillator (AED) donated to the library by Defibtech. The main purpose of an AED is to treat those who suffer sudden cardiac arrest by restarting the heart. Because CPR, while important, doesn't restart the heart of someone who has suffered cardiac arrest and the average wait time for emergency response workers to arrive is on average about six minutes, the AED may save lives.
